 - Increase the efficiency of fleet logistics

Improve Public Transport

- Increase the use of Public Transport
- Expansion of Mass Rapid Transit
- Quality of Bus services develop Gold standard BRTs
- High EE / CNG driven Buses
- Intelligent Routing system
- Real –time passenger information
- convenient ticketing system one ticket for all
- Improve Park & Ride facilities
- Car-pooling vans

Demand Pricing

(once public transport is a good alternative)

- Road User Charges (Time of Use / Zones / Emission)
- Pay-as-you-Drive Insurance

Urban Planning

- TOD with Self Sufficient District
- Better City Planning (zoning Industrial / Commercial / Residential Zoning)
- Bicycle / Walking Lanes street design standard, complete street, traffic calming

Promotion High EE Vehicles

- Eco Cars, FFVs, Hybrid, Hydrogen, EVs
- R&D for fuel efficiency technologies
- Energy Labelling
- Tax privileges for high EE vehicles
- Car parking / HOV lane privilege
